

Vehicles for sale on council and state-controlled roads

Vehicles for sale on council and state-controlled roads are managed by Sunshine Coast Council.

Sunshine Coast Council is committed to providing a well-managed region that promotes and attracts visitors while ensuring a safe and healthy environment.

Vehicles offered for sale from public land create an unsightly environment and pose a risk to motorists by slowing down traffic and distracting drivers.

How do I report a vehicle for sale?

You have several options for reporting vehicles advertised for sale on public land:

- Go to council's website and select 'request a council service online' from the 'Contact Council' page
- Send council an email
- Contact us via phone

When you contact us with your request please ensure you have the following information: a description of the vehicle including colour, make & model and registration number (where possible). We will also need the specific location of the vehicle to assist us in locating it for inspection.

Where can I park my vehicle advertising it for sale?

Vehicles advertised for sale can be parked on private land (with permission of the owner).

What will council do about a vehicle advertised for sale on a road?

Vehicles for sale are regulated by council's Response Services Officers under the appropriate local law:

Local Law No. 4 (Prohibited activities for local government controlled areas, facilities, infrastructure and roads) 2011

The vehicle's condition, location and registration status will be checked and an infringement notice may be issued to the vehicle. Officers may also contact the vehicle owner to request the vehicle be removed from council or state-controlled land.
