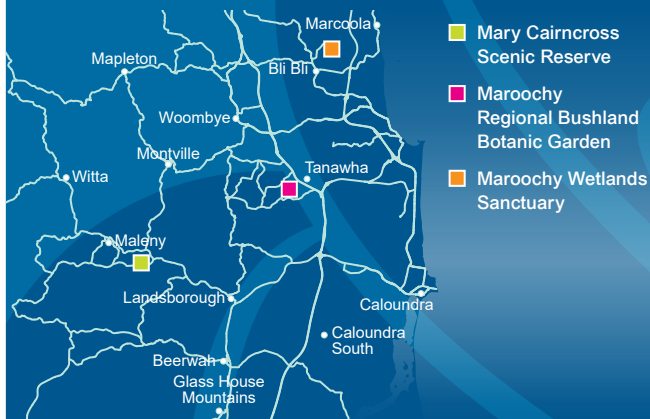

WELCOME

Nestled along the western bank of the Maroochy River, the Maroochy Wetlands Sanctuary is a nature lover's paradise.

Nearly a kilometre of elevated boardwalk takes you through a succession of different vegetation communities including eucalypt forest, casuarina groves, melaleuca woodlands, mangroves, salt marshes and tidal flats. There are plenty of opportunities to observe the many birds, crabs and unique wetland wildlife that call the sanctuary home.

You'll be amazed at the diversity of life thriving on the river's edge.

SEE AND DO

The Maroochy Wetlands Sanctuary is the perfect place to connect with and immerse yourself in nature.

- Stroll along the 900m boardwalk (wheelchair accessible).
- Experience the distinct vegetation communities and the diversity of wildlife they support.
- Watch crabs and fish from the viewing platform.
- Contribute your sightings to the ClimateWatch citizen science program.
- Observe a multitude of bird species.
- Explore the interactive displays inside the Visitor Centre.
- Learn how to identify different mangrove species.
- Listen to the unique sound of the coastal breeze blowing through the casuarina groves.

Please note this is a wetland ecosystem and there are mosquitoes, especially during the summer months. It is recommended to protect yourself against mosquitoes.
